- Interested in helping us improve our support by working on our technical documentation, homepage, Wiki etc.
- Responsible, stable and focused
- Technically experienced with Linux/Solaris environments or willing to learn about them
- Proficient in written communication, primarily in English
- Preferably experienced with using the G-Bar
- Expected to be studying at DTU for at least two years still

What we do

The G-Bar Supporters maintain a number of services in the G-Bar and provide support for its users. This includes helping users with questions either asked by e-mail or by consultation in our office (building 308). We maintain the G-Bar site and Wiki (www.gbar.dtu.dk) where we provide help and answers to common problems. For students with laptops, we provide support for Linux, ThinLinc, and to a limited extent Windows. For the maintenance part, we are responsible for changing the databar hardware (terminals, keyboards, and mice). We work closely with the DTU Computing Center who maintain the software installed on the main G-Bar servers, and we administer a number of small servers ourselves.

What we provide

You will be joining our team of supporters. We are currently four supporters, and the working hours are very flexible. We expect you to have approximately four hours or more in our office per week, but apart from that, you are free to work on your projects when you like. Your projects can be of different character, varying from maintenance, development, technical documentation and homepage administration depending on your skills and interests, and on our forth-coming needs. Each month a meeting is held where the tasks and future plans for the G-Bar are discussed.

The salary is determined according to the collective wage agreement (PROSA overenskomst).

About the G-Bar

The G-Bar, which is short for General Databar, is one of the main databars at DTU and is primarily located in the 3rd quadrant of DTU. The G-Bar is built up of a number of large servers running Linux and Solaris, and the users connect to them via SunRay terminals in the databars or via ThinLinc from their own computers.
